#### Water:

Wanham and Eaglesham have municipal water; a \$500 deposit is required to turn on water. Municipally treated potable water may be purchased by obtaining a keycode from BHC and loading your own tanks at the water treatment plant located in Eaglesham.

#### Garbage

There is curbside pick-up in Eaglesham every Monday morning between 10 am and noon.

## Kakut Lake Fish Pond, Wildlife Conservation Area and Campground

Turnoff on Highway 2, 1 km north of Woking junction, then 11 km east on Secondary 677 which is also known as the Peoria Road. It can also be accessed from highway 733, south of Wanham. There is overnight camping and a fishing pond stocked with Rainbow Trout and Perch. The rest of the lake is very shallow, with it being only 5 feet deep at the centre of the lake. The larger part of the lake has no fish, but plenty of bird life. A great place to paddle a canoe or kayak. (780) 694-2643
